

EMMA MEANS MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES (EMMA Concert Association)

Eligibility: Graduating 12th grade students who are United States citizens and residents of St. Johns County who have been accepted into a music-based program of higher education.

Intent of the Scholarship: To advance the music endeavors of the applicant in his/her chosen field. Student must have a 3.0 grade point average.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Applications must include:

- Letter of Recommendation from the student's music instructor. Letter should include a short history of the teacher's experience with the applicant.
- Name and address of the institution/college that the student will be attending.
- One page essay from the student discussing his/her music goals and how this scholarship will help to achieve those goals.
- Completed application form.
- Audiovisual performance material

PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

Applicants should submit a video of a performance either digitally or in DVD format. DVD should include clear, audible sound and be clearly marked.

Music/Instrumental Audiovisual samples must contain:

- 1 piece demonstrating the range of artistic ability.
- If you play several instruments, please select only one for your application.

Performance Samples:

- Vocal Performance/Voice Applicants should have musical accompaniment (no a cappella performance)
- Music Composition Applicants should submit 1-2 compositions on paper manuscript and provide a recording of the composition being performed.

Dance Audiovisual must contain:

- Solo performance only
- 1 piece in style of your choice
